- 300 ha of greenhouse vegetable production
- 1.000 ha land under irrigation


During an averagely fruitful year, the annual production in the area of the City amounts to 55.000 tons of wheat, 160.000 tons of corn, 1.200 tons of barley (average yield 4t / ha) as well as 65-70.000 tons of different vegetables.

The most common crops



■ Cereals ■ Vegetables ■ Industrial and forage crops

The most abundant crops are cereals with 80% (wheat, corn, barley), vegetables with 8% (cabbage, watermelon, cucumber, peppers, tomato), and industrial crop and feed 12% (sugar beet, tobacco, alfalfa).



PROCESSING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

- Processing of fruit and vegetables: marmalades, juices, compotes, pickled food
